Our team at AMAI is very excited about serving your family this school year. The ASP Registration Packet has all of the information you will need for our program. After reviewing the information please fill out and return to AMAI the following forms:

1. The registration form,
2. Emergency Contact/Health and Insurance form,
3. The rules and policies sheet, initialed and signed &
4. If your child attends a Christina School District school, you will need to complete the transportation form and return it to your child's school.

We will give you a copy of the registration form and rules and policies sheet for you to have for your records.

Included in this packet you will find the 2013/14 school year class schedule, a program description sheet that includes prices and uniforms and equipment that classes may require, an important dates sheet that lists the following: AMAI Closed Dates, Day Camp Schedule for when your child's school is closed, Parents Night Out schedule with themes, and special seminars and community event dates.

All returning ASP kids will be required to purchase a new uniform. Your registration fee is based on the uniform package you select. Athletic shoes are required for all classes. Your child can wear their gym shoes or you can select a package that includes our martial arts shoe. For added convenience, this school year we are providing special packages that can be purchased by our after school program families. These packages bundle many of the purchases that will be required throughout the school year with an added discount for purchasing them in advance. These extra packages include our Test Fee Package, Weapons Package and MMA package.

In order to see the progress your child is making in his/her martial arts studies this school year, we hold a quarterly graduation ceremony for all students to be able to show all of their family and friends what they have been learning. These events are about 45-60 minutes and are a great time for parents to watch their kids in action. In place of the graduation for our winter quarter, we hold an annual dinner banquet. The banquet is the highlight of every year where we spotlight all of our students who were promoted to black belt since last year's banquet. The banquet also features several funny videos, special demo team performances, a video yearbook and more. The banquet is a "dress to impress" event held at the Cavalier Country Club. Tickets for this event will be on sale in February.

AMAI is also a full service family fitness and martial arts school that features classes for children as young as 3 years old through Adults. We offer Chinese martial arts classes for adults and teens as well as kids. Our adult fitness program features our very popular COMBAT FITNESS program. This class incorporates cardio, weight training and bag work. Train like an MMA athlete without the bumps and bruises or getting kicked and punched. You will burn major calories and have a great time doing it. We also offer Tai Chi for adults. Tai Chi is a low impact, meditation with movement type of exercise that many doctors in America are prescribing to their patients to improve strength, flexibility, balance and circulation without putting stress and strain on your joints. With your child enrolled in our After School Program, we offer great discounts on other classes for you or other family members in your household. Be sure to ask about our family plan that gives everyone in your household UNLIMITED CLASSES in EVERY PROGRAM offered at AMAI. A family that trains together stays together!

What other after school program can give the character building skills that martial arts teaches?

Our program for children focuses on teaching discipline, self confidence and respect. Martial arts training also enhances physical agility, strength, endurance, and flexibility in an environment where they can have fun while learning valuable life skills.

Students learn confidence and control as well as how to act and react to the world around them. Our students are treated with respect and are taught to return the same respect to all.

Your child will be picked up from their school or bus stop every day from one of our responsible staff. Upon arriving at the school, your child will change into their martial arts uniform and be able to unwind from the day with snack time and supervised free time. Next, your child will do their homework under the supervision of our ASP Support Team. Your child will also attend their daily martial arts class where they will learn many valuable life skills and lessons of success. When class is over, it's back to homework or supervised activities.

Have peace of mind knowing your child is in a supervised, structured environment until you are finished work and pick them up from our facility.

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Program Descriptions

All children enrolled in our ASP are automatically members of either our Lil' Dragons or our Kids BBC program. Your child's age will determine which program he/she will start off in this school year. Below is an explanation of the different programs and courses you can enroll your child in for the school year.

Lil' Dragons (Ages 5 & 6)

Lil' Dragons have 30 minute classes every day. Kids learn the building blocks for future success with our MAT CHAT character development program. We begin to explore the techniques and moves of the martial arts in the LIL' DRAGONS Program with the focus being on your child's overall development.

Your child will love learning different styles of Chinese Martial Arts such as TIGER, SNAKE, LEOPARD, CRANE, EAGLE, DRAGON and more. These animal styles of kung-fu keep classes fun and interesting for the kids as they learn martial arts skills featured in many hit children's cartoons and movies.

Children in this program test for new belts every three months. Once your child turns 7 years old, they will graduate to our Kids BBC Program

Kids BBC (Black Belt Course) Ages 7-11

The Kids BBC classes are 45 minutes long and are offered several times per day. All of our ASP students will take the first available class, usually around 4:00 or 4:15 PM. Our POWERFUL WORDS character development program is a major part of our kids curriculum. This program teaches children a new leadership or character word every month and defines it in a way that is easy for children to remember. This program also includes a short discussion time where students talk about how they have witnessed or experienced this word in action in their lives. POWERFUL WORDS helps give your child the strong character that is essential in future success in academics, sports, business and in relationships.

Our martial arts curriculum is based on Chinese martial arts. Many of the forms or styles your child will learn involve the imitation of animals such as TIGER, SNAKE, CRANE, EAGLE and more. Each unique style teaches different methods for defending yourself. The animal styles of Kung-fu also allow your child to explore their imagination with physical movement.

Children in this program test for new belts every three months as they work towards earning our DRAGON BLACK BELT. This is our Kids Program Black Belt. Once your child turns 12/13 years old, he/she will graduate to our teen/adult program.

Weapons Program

Our weapons program introduces your child to various Chinese martial arts weapons. Every three months your child will study a new Chinese weapon form. The weapons we will be teaching this school year include the Butterfly swords, the Broadsword and the Chinese Spear. Why add weapons to your child's training? The study of weapons increases the development of strength, balance and coordination. It's like adding weights to your workout routine. Another very important reason to study weapons is to continue the traditions and legacy of ancient methods of self defense. Why will your child want to study weapons? For them, because it's SUPER COOL and FUN! The required uniform for this class is the same uniform as the BBC class. This program is available for kids ages 7 and older. Children in this program are tested on this material as part of their quarterly test if they are enrolled in this program. There is an additional fee of \$7.50 per week for this class.



Acrobatics Class

Our Acrobatics program teaches children the skills commonly seen in a gymnastics floor routine. This curriculum includes: forward rolls, backwards rolls, cart wheels, hand stands, hand springs, front flips, back flips and more. Chinese martial arts often includes many acrobatic skills to increase the difficulty level of routines in competition or in demonstrations. The biggest thing needed for children to learn these skills is consistent and regular practice. Our Acrobatics program will provide that. The required uniform for this class is AMAI T-Shirt, martial arts pants or AMAI shorts. No belt required. This class is open to both Lil' Dragons and Kids BBC students. There is an additional weekly fee of \$6.25. Classes are offered once during the week and once on Saturday. Students may attend both classes if enrolled in the Acrobatics program. Students are not tested on this material on their martial arts belt tests.

MMA Class

Our kids MMA program is NOT a competitive program but we do teach the skills used in the popular sport of MMA or Mixed Martial Arts. MMA incorporates the hand skills of boxing, the kicking skills of Tai-Kickboxing, takedown skills and controlling an opponent with free style wrestling and the submission skills of Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu. Every week, a new skill set will be practiced. Students will drill these skills on various bags and with other students. This is a contact sport that requires proper safety equipment. The equipment package is \$200 and includes headgear with face shield, boxing gloves, shin guards, mma gloves and a mouth piece. The cost of this class is \$6.25 per week. This program is open to boys and girls in the kids BBC program however AMAI does not teach jiu-jitsu to girls. Our focus with girls is to train them how to avoid being taken to the ground. This class is offered on Fridays after school. Students in this class can wear either AMAI pants or AMAI shorts, AMAI T-shirt and the proper safety equipment.

Leadership Program

Our Leadership program serves as both a young leaders training program and an AMAI Instructor training program. All members of our AMAI team have come from our Leadership Training Program. In this class, students learn the proper protocols for leading classes and more important, how to be an effective assistant instructor and team member. This class practices public speaking, does reading from various books from Zig Ziglar, John Maxwell and others. The leadership students also have the privilege of putting their skills into practice by assisting in younger kids program classes. Our Leadership team can be distinguished by their black and blue uniforms. There are different uniforms in this program to show rank and progress within this program. Students enrolled in this program are held to a higher standard in AMAI as they are expected to be positive leaders and role models in the school and community. The Level 1 Leadership uniform is \$80 and is required for all Leadership students. The weekly fee for this class is \$6.25. Leadership class meets every Friday.

___ 1. The American Martial Arts Institute uses **Champions Way/Perfect Mind** to manage and collect all tuition payments. CW/PM charges a **\$10.00 LATE FEE** for all payments that are 10 days past due. They also charge **\$35.00 NSF CHARGE** for any initial payment that is returned due to insufficient funds. AMAI's financial officer is Ms. Paulina Papili. She can be contacted at (302)834-4060 with any billing questions. To avoid late fees and NSF fees, please contact Paulina to discuss your account and to make arrangements before fees are charged to your account.

___ 2. I understand that The American Martial Arts Institute is a martial arts school and NOT a day care center. In addition to martial arts, we teach character development, behavior skills, life skills and safety skills. With your acknowledging the rules and guidelines below, we can be more effective in teaching your children these valuable skills.

___ 3. I understand that my child MUST bring their uniform everyday to AMAI. If my child does not have their uniform, one will be given to him/her and I will be charged for the cost of the uniform. *The cost for each uniform piece is: \$25 Shoes, \$25 Pants, \$25 uniform jacket. \$15 Belt, \$20 T-shirts*

___ 4. I understand that my child must take classes everyday they attend the AMAI ASP if one is available during the time my child is present. If you do not want your child to attend class on a particular day, please be sure to notify AMAI by telephone, email or note sent with your child. We will not simply go on the word of your child. If your child arrives to AMAI and is unable to participate due to illness or other medical reason you may be contacted to have your child picked up for the day.

___ 5. Your child will be tested on material they have learned and awarded a belt to show their rank or level in our martial arts program. These tests are conducted in August, November, March and May of each year. If your child misses a test or does not attend the proper classes to learn the required material your child will not test and remain at their current rank. The test fee is \$25 which pays for your child's new sash and certificate. **Your account on file will be billed the test fee on the day your child tests unless you make other arrangements.**

___ 6. If your child needs to be picked up while they would normally be in class, you must send a note or call notifying us of the change in schedule. Part of our program is teaching children discipline and respect. We need your help by respecting our class times and schedules. Having a child leave class without prior notification is a disruption to those in class.

___ 7. I understand that the AMAI after school program runs the entire school year. My tuition is based on the total number of weeks in the school year including holiday and vacation days. I am billed for weeks even if my child is not in school or using the after school program unless I provide proper notification to remove my child from the program. **CHAMPIONSWAY/PERFECT MIND REQUIRES TWO WEEKS WRITTEN NOTICE TO cancel your child's enrollment from our After School Program.**

___ 8. When schools are closed for holidays or teacher in-service days, I can still utilize the AMAI after school program by bringing my child to AMAI during their regular after school program times (3:30 or 4:00 pm until 6:00 pm or until the last available class for my child has ended.)

___ 9. When my child's school is closed for holiday or vacation, unless AMAI is also closed, DAY CAMP will be available for an additional fee of \$25 per day. **UNLESS I PAY FOR DAY CAMP AT THE TIME MY CHILD IS DROPPED OFF, I AUTHORIZE AMAI TO CHARGE MY ACCOUNT ON FILE FOR THIS SERVICE.**

___ 10. Your child will have snack time upon arriving at AMAI everyday. I understand my child will need a HEALTHY SNACK and DRINK everyday for snack time. Snacks can also be purchased at AMAI. Snack prices vary. You may also set up a PREPAID Snack account for your child. Please see an instructor for details on our prepaid snack plans.

___ 11. AMAI is closed for winter vacation Monday, December 23rd through Wednesday, January 1st 2014. My child's school is also closed at this time for winter break. **NO CLASSES OR DAY CAMPS WILL BE AVAILABLE DURING WINTER BREAK.** I also understand I will be charged for this time in my child's tuition.

___ 12. The person picking up your child is required to sign him/her out everyday with the time of pick up and the pick up persons initials. If you fail to sign out your child an AMAI staff member will and these times CAN NOT BE DISPUTED if a late sign out requires an Extended care fee to be billed to my account on file. See #13 for these fees.

___ 13. **EXTENDED ASP FEES:** Late pick up is available for an additional fee. Extended ASP rates are \$5 for the first half hour per day and \$10 for the second half hour per day. Extended ASP fees will be charged to the account on file on Friday of every week. You will receive an email receipt showing the times your child was signed out and the amount billed for each day that week.

TEST WEEKS

Your child will test for his or her next belt in our martial arts program throughout the school year. The following are the dates we will be conducting belt testing.
