Grandmaster Brad Shipp has over 35 years martial arts experience and has been teaching for the past 27 years and is currently a 9th degree black belt in Chun Kuhn Taekwondo. He began training martial arts in St. Louis, Missouri at Kim's Academy of Tae Kwon do in 1988 at the age of 11. After three years of concentrated study under the direct supervision of Supreme Master Bok Man Kim he attained the rank of 1st Degree Black Belt. As a teenager, Grandmaster Shipp showed promise as a martial arts instructor and was promoted to assistant instructor and assisted Supreme Master Kim in teaching classes and training the demonstration team.

In 1995 Grandmaster Shipp moved from St. Louis, MO to Seattle, WA to begin training under Supreme Master Kim's son. During this intense training Grandmaster Shipp became a certified instructor as well as a Survival Training Instructor. Survival training included: Mountain Survival, Ocean Survival, Desert Survival, Snow Survival, and Rescue Survival Training.

In 1997 Grandmaster Shipp attained the rank of 4th Degree Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do. It was at this time he opened his first martial arts studio in Woodinville, WA.

In 2000 Master Daniel McCarter took over the Woodinville Academy and Grandmaster Shipp moved back to St. Louis, MO. Grandmaster Shipp opened his second martial arts studio in O'Fallon, MO. One year later he attained the rank of 5th Degree Black Belt Tae Kwon Do.

In April of 2008 Grandmaster Shipp opened his third martial arts Studio in Roseland, NJ. This location is being supervised by Supreme Master Bok Man Kim. Founder of World Chun Kuhn Do Federation.

In September 2009 Grandmaster Shipp visited **Seoul Korea** to participate in a lecture on Tae Kwon Do at Yong In University.

In September 2011 Grandmaster Shipp visited **Singapore** to assist Supreme Master Bok Man Kim in teaching a Chun Kuhn Do seminar to the leaders of the Tae Kwon Do community.

In September 2013 Grandmaster Shipp visited **Derby, Kansas** to conduct a seminar and establish the Kansas Chun Kuhn Do Association.

In May of 2014 Grandmaster Shipp visited **London, England** to conduct 3 seminars and conduct testing for 4th and 7th degree black belts. He also met with the leaders of the World Chun Kuhn Do Federation UK to set up future events.

In September of 2015 Grandmaster Shipp visited The **Netherlands** to assist Supreme Master Bok Man Kim in teaching a 2 day International Instructors Course for ITF, Headquarters Korea.

In April of 2016 Grandmaster Shipp visited **Moscow, Russia** to conduct a technical seminar on Taekwondo as well as attend the World Championships.

In November of 2016 Grandmaster Shipp visited **Puerto Rico** with Supreme Master Bok Man Kim to conduct a 2 day seminar for the World Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Federation.

In September of 2017 Grandmaster Shipp coached four students: Valerie Genis, Michael Genis, Justin Capizano, and Cody Capizano at the **World Championships in the Netherlands**. We earned 3 gold medals and 1 bronze medal for Team USA.

In February of 2017 Grandmaster Shipp visited Boscobel, Wisconsin with Supreme Master Bok Man Kim to

conduct a technical seminar on Chun Kuhn Taekwondo. This seminar led to the creation of the Wisconsin State Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Federation.

In July of 2018 Grandmaster Shipp visited **Seattle, Washington** with Supreme Master Bok Man Kim to conduct a technical seminar on Chun Kuhn Taekwondo. This seminar led to the creation of the Washington State Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Federation.

In September of 2018 Grandmaster Shipp and Supreme Master Bok Man Kim visited **Austria and the Czech Republic** to conduct a technical seminar on Chun Kuhn Taekwondo.

In October of 2018 Grandmaster Shipp and Supreme Master Bok Man Kim visited **Plano**, **Texas** to conduct a 2 day technical seminar on Chun Kuhn Taekwondo for **the United Taekwondo Alliance**. Following the seminar, the **Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Founder's Committee** was formed. With the creation of the Founder's Committee, the **United States Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Federation has representatives in 20 states**.

In May of 2019, Grandmaster Shipp and Supreme Master Kim returned to the **Czech Republic** to teach technical seminars in both **Brno** and **Predni Vyton**. The students in the Czech Republic are eager to learn Supreme Master Kim's weapons and self-defense curriculum.

In July of 2019, Grandmaster Shipp, Supreme Master Kim, and Master Clint traveled with a team of 13 students to the **United Taekwondo Alliance Grand Nationals in Shreveport, LA**. The Complete Martial Arts team received numerous medals in the competition.

In February of 2020, Grandmaster Shipp and Supreme Master Kim returned to **Boscobel, Wisconsin**, to visit with the Wisconsin State Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Federation to complete photos for the Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Encyclopedia series of books they will be publishing.

In October of 2020, Grandmaster Shipp and Supreme Master Kim traveled to **Omaha**, **NE for the Omaha National Martial Arts Championship**, where afterwards Supreme Master Kim was inducted into the USKF Black Belt Hall of Fame.

In July of 2021, Grandmaster Shipp and Supreme Master Kim published Volume 2 of the Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Encyclopedia.

On August 14, 2021 Grandmaster Shipp and Supreme Master Kim organized a **Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Seminar and Book Signing Party**. This was attended by Masters and Grand Masters from around the United States, as well as Puerto Rico.

In November 2021, Grandmaster Shipp returned once again to **Boscobel**, **WI** to kick off a **Legacy Tour** in honor of Supreme Master Kim and teach a self-defense seminar and attend a book signing party for Volume 2 of the Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Encyclopedia.

In February 2022, Grandmaster Shipp traveled to **Kirkland**, **WA** on the 2nd stop on the Legacy Tour in honor of Supreme Master Kim, to teach a self-defense and knife seminar to the students at Jungyae Martial Arts Kirkland and Woodinville Martial Arts.

In March 2022, Grandmaster Shipp and Master Clint Wehner traveled to **Omaha**, **NE** to attend the **Omaha National Martial Arts Championship**, where afterwards Grand Master Shipp was inducted into the USKF Black Belt Hall of Fame.

In June 2022, Grandmaster Shipp and Master Clint traveled with 18 students to **United Taekwondo Alliance Grand Nationals in Tulsa, OK**. The Complete Martial Arts team again received numerous competition medals.

In July 2022, Grandmaster Shipp, along with students Justin and Cody Capizano and Valerie Genis, Grand

Master Raymond Saint from Boscobel, WI, and Grand Master El from Lansing, IL, traveled back to Czech Republic to teach a 3-day self-defense and weapons seminar at the Chun Kuhn Taekwondo Summer Camp in Velesin.

In August 2022, Grandmaster Shipp and Master Clint traveled to **Woodinville**, **WA** to celebrate the 25th anniversary of Grand Master Shipp's first martial arts school, **Woodinville Martial Arts**. While there, they taught a knife and self-defense seminar to the students from Woodinville and Jungyae Moosul Martial Arts Kirkland.

Students of Complete Martial Arts believe they are very fortunate to be able to train under the oversight of a Grand Master who is totally dedicated to their students and the Martial Arts.

WHITE BELT: 10TH GRADE	YELLOW BELT: 9TH GRADE
ORANGE BELT: 8TH GRADE	GREEN BELT: 7TH GRADE
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BLUE BELT: 6TH GRADE	BLUE 1ST BELT: 5TH GRADE
RED BELT: 4TH GRADE	RED 1ST BELT: 3RD GRADE

As students progress they will earn stripes or tips on their belt. Stripes are given approximately every 5 classes or upon the instructors discretion. The third stripe signifies that the student is ready to take a test for belt promotion.



COMPLETE MARTIAL ARTS RANKING SYSTEM

The different belt colors symbolize the various stages of physical and mental development in the martial arts. At each level the martial artist is mindful of those who are Junior to his rank and how his knowledge gained through experience may be of service to them. He is also aware of his Seniors and the experiences they have had as well that will help him to reach his ultimate goal of Black Belt.

Belt Rank	<u>Interpretation</u>
	A student who has no knowledge of the art. White, being a non-color, expresses a Void , no action.
	Yellow represents Caution, careful slow movement.
	Orange represents the rising sun. Through the development of self discipline the student realizes the importance of Etiquette .
	The student receives his first dark color, representing his Desire to Learn .
	The student has begun to ascent to a higher plane of Concentration .
	Through concentration, the student begins to develop keen mental and physical Focus .
	Through diligent practice, the student has begun to amass Skill.
	Through repetition of techniques, the student is now developing Speed.
	Through diligent training and commitment the student develops physical Strength and mental Endurance .
	The student begins to apply their knowledge with increased Accuracy.
	The student has graduated to a Degree in Complete Martial Arts. There are eleven degrees of black belt that can be earned.
