

General Rental Procedures & Standards

The Claremont Savings Bank Community Center has excellent meeting room spaces available for rent.

Kitchen is available for use by group or caterer. Kitchen is equipped with refrigerator, ice maker, warming oven, microwave, and sinks. Add-on charge \$50 per rental.

Food and drinks are limited to meeting rooms, game room, multi-purpose rooms, kitchen, and vending areas.

Decorations are allowed on dining tables and buffet tables only. All decorations will be provided by the renting group. No decorations may be attached to the walls or ceilings of the facility. Archways or other backdrops must be free standing and may not be attached to the walls. Large banners or posters must be approved by facility management. Confetti or tape of any type is not allowed. Please ask the office if you have a specific request.

All rentals must be requested at least 7 days in advance by completing a facility rental application and submitting a payment in full. Events canceled less than 7 days in advance will not be eligible for refund. The City of Claremont will submit a damage claim in the event of damage to the Community Center or its contents. The City of Claremont reserves the right to refuse any rental requests. Use that requires a fee by participants or is for-profit oriented in nature is discouraged.

Pool Party Package

\$120 per party

Pool Party time slots are available on a first come, first serve basis on Saturdays and Sundays throughout the year.

Slots are: 11am-1pm, 2pm-4pm, & 5pm-7pm
Please ask about availability of pool party on weekdays and weeknights

Pool Party Package includes 1st hour in the pool and one hour for cake and presents in the party room. Two hours total.

Up to 12 swimmers. Each additional swimmer is a \$5 charge.



Grand Meeting Conference Package

6-hour Minimum- \$470, \$105 for each additional hour

The Grand Meeting Room seats up to 200 individuals and can easily host an intimate to large social group gathering, from business to fun we've got you covered. Prices do not include use of the kitchen. Alcohol service requires a City of Claremont Licensing Board approval. Grand Meeting Room rentals may incur staff costs for set-up and take down. All after-hour rentals also incur staff costs. After-hours begin at 9pm on Monday-Thursday, 8pm on Fridays, 8pm on Saturdays and Sundays.

Room Rentals

2-hour Minimum- Function Room A - \$120

Function Room B - \$160 Function Room G - \$90

Rates for meetings and conferences do not include set-up and take down, kitchen use, or staff requirements. Contact CSBCC for a specific cost estimate of your rental request if you need special assistance. Function room rentals require a minimum reservation block of 2 hours.

Rules & Regulations

Every participant must have a valid membership or purchase a day pass and must check in at the front desk upon entry.

Each area of the community center has its own specific set of rules. Please refer to and comply with each area's designated set of rules when using the facility.

Participants 12-15 can use the fitness/cardio space, but must have completed the youth fitness orientation.

Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older while using the facility. Caregiver must be alert, aware and providing direct supervision to the dependent.

Children 5 years and older must use gender appropriate locker room facility or please use family changing rooms.

CSBCC is a tobacco, vape, alcohol, and drug-free campus.
