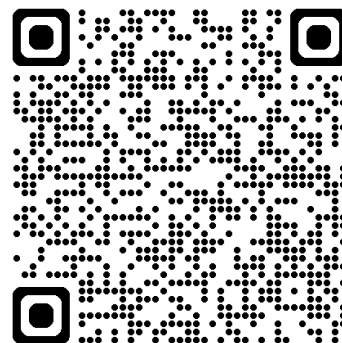

Dear Masters, Instructors, and TNSA Members,

The TNSA is excited to present its first Umpire Training Course (UTC). The course will take place on Saturday, June 8, 2024, 13:00-17:00 at MacKenzie Atlantic Taekwon-Do in Hammonds Plains, NS. Doors open at 12:30.

The course content will focus on the roles of Corner Umpire and Centre Referee. The major topics of this course are:

- Safety & Concussion Awareness
- The Role and Responsibilities of an Umpire
- Individual Patterns
- Individual Sparring

Participants will be briefed on introductory topics, match procedures, scoring systems, and scoring techniques. Course content will be delivered using a blend of lecture-based content delivery, along with interactive demonstrations. Participants will be afforded opportunities to practice skills in various roles.

The UTC provides access to supplemental materials, known as Quick Reference Sheets (QRSs). The role of the QRSs is to improve standardization of procedures and adherence to official rules. Participants will be provided access to digital copies of the QRSs after registering. Participants are asked to have them available at the course.

Following the conclusion of the course, participants will be assigned an online, open book exam. A component of the exam requires participants to upload certification of successful completion of the Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT). The exam must be submitted by 23:59 on June 15, 2024. Participants who receive an exam score of 60 or higher will receive a Certificate of Completion from the TNSA. Successful completion of the UTC also meets the "Provincial Umpire Course" requirement in the CTFI's *Black Belt Requirements in Canada*.

The UTC is available only to individuals who are age 12 or above & hold a minimum rank of Blue Belt. Participants must wear their full Dobok while attending the UTC.

This course charges a registration fee of \$30. Register by 23:59 on June 5, 2024. This course has a limit of 40 participants.
