

## **Rules and Important Information**

- 1. Teams can range in size from 1 to 8 people.
- 2. A team representative should register once as a team for each Trivia Tuesday. Please complete the questionnaire at registration stating how many players will be on your team.
- 3. There will be 3 trivia rounds each Tuesday with 15 questions per round. Each question is worth 100 points. Points will not be deducted for wrong answers.
  - a. June 15 TV Sitcoms
    - i. Golden Girls
    - ii. Seinfeld
    - iii. The Office
  - b. June 22 Movies
    - i. Movie Quotes
    - ii. Soundtracks
    - iii. Name that Movie GIF
  - c. June 29 Music
    - i. Band Name Origins
    - ii. One-Hit Wonders
    - iii. Name that Album Cover
- 4. Each team will designate a "captain" who will be responsible for submitting the team's answers by smart phone.
- 5. Each team's captain will need to go to <u>www.crowdpurr.com</u> to enter the evening's game using the event code displayed on the stage.
- 6. Each team's captain will then submit the team's name before the first round begins.
- 7. There will be a 5 minute countdown that appears on the team captain's smart phone prior to the start of the event.
- 8. The Emcee will read each question, which will also appear on the captain's smart phone. Teams will have 60 seconds to work together to select their answer. The team captain will then submit the team's answer.
- 9. The Emcee will announce the correct answer, which will also appear on the captain's smart phone.
- 10. Answers from each team will be automatically scored and tallied as the game progresses. Rankings will be announced at the end of each round.
- 11. After the final round for the evening, all final scores will be announced and prizes awarded to the teams with the 3 highest scores of the evening.
- 12. NO cell phones or electronic devices of any kind may be used during the game except by each team's captain. If a team is found to be in violation of this rule, that team will be disqualified.
