

## **FDLC Gymnastics Gala Day**

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### **Registration requirements**

- Gala Day entry must be registered through the “Gala Day Registration” form sent to the email address provided upon gymnastics enrolment
- Requests for late registrations must be communicated via email to [gymnastics@fdlc.com.au](mailto:gymnastics@fdlc.com.au) and will be considered up until the date stated in the registration email

#### **Payment and Fees**

- Registrations made within the registration period outlined on the “Gala Day Registration” form will be charged a fee of \$30.00 per entrant
- Late registrations will be charged a fee of \$36.00 per entrant
- Fees will be processed by our accounts team after the closing of the registration form, or as soon as possible in the case of late registrations
- Fees will be charged to the account linked to gymnastics debits
- The Gala Day entry fee is non-refundable and non-transferrable in all cases

#### **Confirmation**

- Registration confirmation and session times will be communicated via email approximately one week before the Gala’s scheduled date

#### **Requests for time changes or session movement**

Please note that with a registration maximum of 130 participants, requests for time changes or session movements may not be accommodated.

- Requests for session transfers should be communicated via email to [gymnastics@fdlc.com.au](mailto:gymnastics@fdlc.com.au), however they are not guaranteed

#### **Late arrivals**

Gymnasts must arrive on time to warm up.

- Gymnasts who miss warm up will not be accepted into the Gala

#### **Early departure**

- For a complete assessment, participants must complete all necessary apparatus
- In the case where a participant needs to depart early, this information must be communicated to a Gala coach upon arrival
- In the case where a participant’s early departure causes them to miss an apparatus, the participant forfeits the chance to compete the apparatus and will not receive the related ribbon

#### **During the Gala**

- All parents and/ or carers and viewers of the Gala must remain in the upstairs mezzanine or view from the ground floor glass window
- Parents and/ or carers and viewers are NOT to enter the gymnastics hall
- Parents and/ or carers and viewers are not to approach judges or coaches during the Gala’s operation

### **Bathroom and Water breaks**

Please note, Gala Day does not include scheduled bathroom or water breaks. As a public venue, FDLC's bathroom facilities and water bubblers are shared with other patrons in the centre and members of the public.

- Parents and/or carers are expected to take their child/ren to the bathroom prior to the commencement of Gala Day, and during its operation if necessitated

### **Ribbons and Scoring**

Ribbons are awarded in line with Gymnastics NSW events.

- Participants will be scored based on this criterion and receive the corresponding ribbon
- In the case where a participant has forfeited an apparatus, they will not receive the related ribbon
- In the case where a participant has forfeited an apparatus, their assessment will be considered incomplete which will be reflected in their score
- Scores will be communicated via email to the address provided upon gymnastics enrolment, and will be titled "Assessment Report"

### **Gymnast Collection**

On completion of the Gala, gymnasts will exit the gymnastics hall using the back staircase to the mezzanine.

- Parents and/ or carers are required to collect their gymnast via the mezzanine and must remain there until collection.
- Gymnasts will not be released from the gymnastics hall entrance/exit door.
