Please come to your regular scheduled classes and additional classes below:

Saturday 11:30 - 12:30pm. Friday classes will be extended, to 8:30 PM

Senior kids, 10 years plus may also come on Tuesday Thursday at 5pm for grappling practice.

Adult and Teens. All belts tournament prep - October 9th to November 1st

Please come to your regular scheduled classes, Tuesday and Thursday at 5pm will now be focused on grappling. Additional classes below:

Saturday 9:00am - 10:30am. MMA boot camp fitness classes 6:15 am and 12 pm Monday, Wednesday, Friday.

Tuesday and Thursday at 8:15pm. If you would like to referee or judge, please come to some of the kid's classes for training. (please see above for more details)

Studio closures: Closed Monday October 9th for thanksgiving. Wednesday Oct 31st, for Halloween, Open Nov 1st for training. Closed Friday, November 2nd tournament set up day. Adult students and parents, if you can volunteer the day before the tournament, we could use some help at 8pm. We will need a larger crew at 7am at the genesis center this year, as we cannot set up in the gym the night before this year. Thank you.
